



Glendale storyteller George Macpherson regales an audience in Berne

Switzerland and Scotland forge links

Switzerland and Scotland have forged a connection through two artists in a unique exhibition featuring photography and storytelling.

At the Botanic Gardens of Berne, Switzerland,

an innovative exhibition has combined the work of Swiss photographer Anja Tanner and the storytelling of George Macpherson of Glendale, Skye, in a visual and oral display.

The exhibition, Clacharan (Stepping Stones), is the result of almost a year's discussion and two

months' interaction between the artists.

At the opening Mr MacPherson gave three live storytelling performances, including stories specially requested by the audience.

The exhibition runs in Berne until this Saturday and will appear in Basle and Edinburgh next year.
